### Some Rules and Regulations for Visitors

Begin your stay at the park head quarter – Neri

- To visit Mago National Park it is not just to see wildlife only but also the life styles and culture of surrounding people.
- Mursi people at Hailwuha Village 62 km from park head quarter there fore
- Karo people at Karo Village 67 km from park head quarter there fore consider the distances before you plan to move to Hailwuha and Karo Villages of surrounding people of Mursi and Karo respectively.
- Be accompanied by park game ranger within National park and also when you plan to move to Mursi Village at Hailwuha.
- Obtain your copy of a receipt of an entrance fee and show wherever you are asked to do so.

### Prohibited activities within national park

- Riding a motor cycle
- Collecting wild flora fauna and their products
- Carrying machine guns

Tours, drivers etc. are responsible for any action to be taken in violation of these rules and regulations.

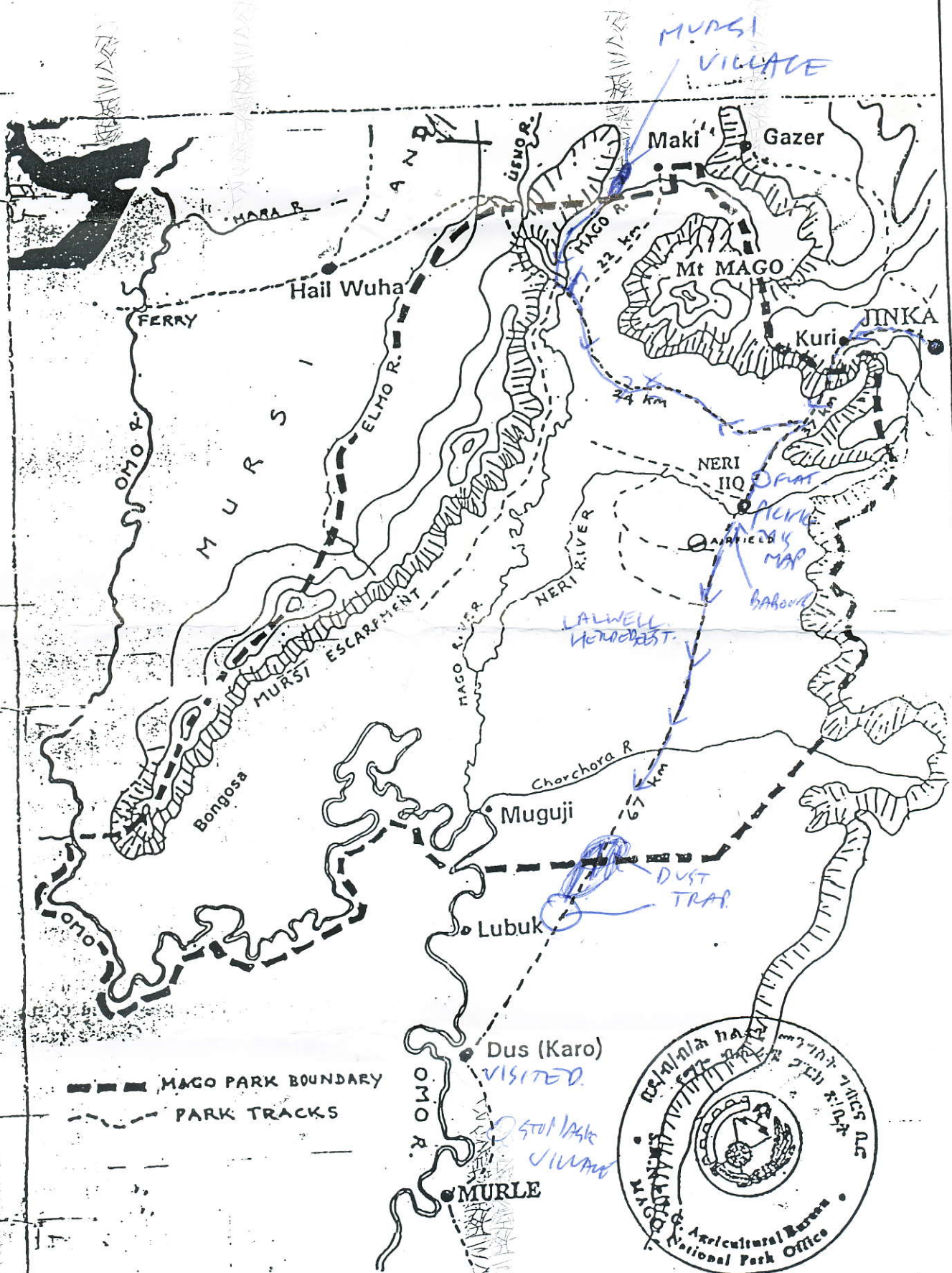
