RULES:

- Everyone has been split into pairs, based on their self-assessed ability. Each pair has been designed to be as good as any other.
- Each batting pair faces 4 overs of bowling – Batsman 1 plays the first 2 overs and Batsman 2 faces the last 2.
- Each bowling pair bowls 4 overs – Bowler 1 bowls overs 1 and 3 and bowler 2 bowls overs 2 and 4.
- Only runs scored off the bat count towards each pair's total.
- An extra ball is awarded for Wides and No-balls. Players are encouraged to have a go at bowling properly, but can bowl underarm, throw the ball or stand closer if agreed with the umpire.
- Five runs are deducted for each wicket lost.
- Five runs are added for each wicket taken.
- At the end of the 'Group' stage, the two highest scoring teams will contest a 4-over a-side final. Should there be a tie, the team losing the fewest wickets shall qualify. If there is still a tie, a super over will be contested. Each pair will have to select one person as the bowler and one as the batsman.
- We have a small playing area and 'big hits' are prohibited. We are therefore adopting a six and out rule (so in effect, the six counts as 1 run).
- The Umpire's decision is final!
